THE PAVILION AT TOYOTA MUSIC FACTORY

The Pavilion at Toyota Music Factory is exclusively booked and promoted by Live Nation and is the centerpiece of the Toyota Music Factory. The state-of-the-art venue is 115,300 square feet of indoor space with expansive outdoor lawns. It converts from a 2,500-capacity intimate theater to a 4,000-seat indoor theater and then at the touch of a button opens up to an 8,000-person boutique open-air amphitheater. The Pavilion at Toyota Music Factory will host a variety of world-class entertainment events throughout the year, including ZZ Top opening the venue on Sept. 9. The space is available for special events and managed by Live Nation.

OFFICE TOWER

LOCATION

Located on the north side of SH 114 and just west of the Las Colinas Urban Center, the address for the Toyota Music Factory is 300 W. Las Colinas Blvd., Irving, Texas 75039. There will be plentiful valet stands throughout and 4,200 dedicated parking spaces available for patrons. The Toyota Music Factory is adjacent to the Irving Convention Center and the 350-room Westin Hotel (under construction). The site is served by the DART Orange Line and as well as the Las Colinas People Mover System. The Toyota Music Factory is 12.5 miles from downtown Dallas, 10 miles from DFW International Airport and 31 miles from downtown Fort Worth.
